

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3355

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 26 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. As used in sections 2 and 3 of this 2021 Act:**

3 **“(1) ‘Crowd management’ means a public security practice in which large crowds of 50**
4 **persons or more are managed to prevent the outbreak of crowd crushes, affrays, fights or**
5 **riots.**

6 **“(2) ‘Law enforcement agency’ means the Oregon State Police, a county sheriff’s office,**
7 **a municipal police department or a police department established by a university under ORS**
8 **352.121 or 353.125.**

9 **“(3) ‘Law enforcement officer’ means a member of the Oregon State Police, a sheriff or**
10 **deputy sheriff, a municipal police officer or a police officer commissioned by a university**
11 **under ORS 352.121 or 353.125.**

12 **“SECTION 2. (1) A law enforcement officer who is on duty and assigned to work crowd**
13 **management in a city with a population of over 150,000 shall have:**

14 **“(a) The officer’s first initial and last name, or a unique identifier assigned by the**
15 **officer’s law enforcement agency, affixed to the front of the officer’s uniform;**

16 **“(b) The officer’s first initial and last name, or a unique identifier assigned by the**
17 **officer’s law enforcement agency, affixed to the back of the officer’s uniform;**

18 **“(c) If wearing a tactical helmet and assigned a unique identifier by the officer’s law**
19 **enforcement agency, the unique identifier affixed to the back of the officer’s helmet;**

20 **“(d) The name of the jurisdiction of the officer’s law enforcement agency and the word**
21 **‘POLICE,’ ‘SHERIFF’ or ‘TROOPER’ on the front and back of the officer’s uniform; and**

22 **“(e) A patch signifying the officer’s law enforcement agency affixed to one shoulder.**

23 **“(2) The information required under subsection (1) of this section shall be affixed in a**
24 **manner that makes the letters and numbers clearly visible.**

25 **“(3) A law enforcement agency shall adopt a policy prohibiting the intentional obscuring**
26 **by a law enforcement officer of any of the information required under subsection (1) of this**
27 **section.**

28 **“(4) This section does not apply to members of the Oregon State Police.”.**
