

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3394

June 21

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, before the period insert “; and prescribing an effective
2 date”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 5 through 10 and insert “shall provide an opportunity for public com-
4 ment.

5 “(5)(a) On or before March 1, 2022, the task force shall deliver a report on its progress to the
6 standing or interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to rules.

7 “(b) No later than December 1, 2022, the task force shall submit a final report on its findings
8 and recommendations, which may include recommendations for legislation, to the standing or interim
9 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to rules.”.

10 In line 21, delete “Legislative Fiscal Office” and insert “Legislative Policy and Research
11 Office”.

12 Delete lines 29 through 36 and insert:

13 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS chapter 461, during the time
14 period beginning on the effective date of this 2021 Act and ending on January 2, 2023, the
15 Oregon State Lottery Commission may not authorize, and the Oregon State Lottery may not
16 implement, any lottery games playable on a mobile device, personal computer or other per-
17 sonal electronic device that were not authorized or implemented before the effective date of
18 this 2021 Act.**

19 **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits the Oregon State Lottery from entering into new
20 contracts with video lottery game retailers, as defined in ORS 461.217, or carrying out ex-
21 isting contracts with video lottery game retailers.**

22 **“SECTION 4. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021
23 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
