

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5016

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for
4 payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee, for the following
5 purposes:

6 (1) General program..... \$ 47,612,107

7 (2) Debt service \$ 29,532,444

8 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment
10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
11 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Adminis-
12 tration Committee:

13 (1) General program..... \$ 1,575,225

14 (2) Debt service \$ 1

15 “**SECTION 3.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Legislative
16 Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies
17 Stores Account established in ORS 173.790 are not limited.

18 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
19 \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
20 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
21 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-
22 ministration Committee, for expenses related to the Oregon Capitol History Gateway from
23 the Oregon Capitol History Gateway Fund.

24 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$25,000
25 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of
26 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
27 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Adminis-
28 tration Committee, for expenses related to operations for the Oregon State Capitol
29 Foundation from the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Operating Fund.

30 “**SECTION 6.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-
31 ning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$20,514,607 for payment of the ex-
32 penses of the following offices:

33 “(1) The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-
34 sentatives;

35 “(2) The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the House of Representatives;

1 and

2 “(3) The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives.

4 “SECTION 7. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium
5 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$29,325,181 for payment of the
6 expenses of members of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

7 “(2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July
8 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$16,266,508 for payment of the expenses of
9 members of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

10 “SECTION 8. There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-
11 ning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,709,647 for the Legislative Equity
12 Office.

13 “SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
14 \$147,199 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
15 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
16 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative As-
17 sembly.

18 “SECTION 10. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Legislative
19 Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account established in ORS 171.117, for the costs of
20 food served in members’ lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or
21 by payroll deductions from members, are not limited.

22 “SECTION 11. There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
23 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$18,279,791.

24 “SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
25 \$2,145,209 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
26 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
27 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
28 Committee.

29 “SECTION 13. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Legislative
30 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established in ORS 171.305 and from
31 the Legislative Publications Account established in ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
32 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
33 Statutes, are not limited.

34 “SECTION 14. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
35 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,383,386.

36 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$4,875,014 is es-
37 tablished for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-
38 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
39 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Fiscal Officer.

40 “SECTION 15. There is appropriated to the Legislative Policy and Research Committee,
41 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$15,386,729.

42 “SECTION 16. There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
43 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,400,900.

44 “SECTION 17. There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
45 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$916,721.

1 **“SECTION 18. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$7,604**
2 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of**
3 **expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
4 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian**
5 **Services.**

6 **“SECTION 19. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
7 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
8 **July 1, 2021.”.**

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
