

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5025

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
3 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment
4 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
5 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Parks and Recre-
6 ation Department, for the following purposes:

- 7 (1) Director’s office \$ 941,725
8 (2) Central services \$ 20,114,569
9 (3) Parks development..... \$ 4,983,803
10 (4) Direct services..... \$ 71,291,958
11 (5) Community support
12 and grants..... \$ 18,363,616

13 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
14 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment
15 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to
16 the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the following purposes:

- 17 (1) Director’s office \$ 1,521,609
18 (2) Central services \$ 19,954,304
19 (3) Parks development..... \$ 16,211,364
20 (4) Direct services..... \$ 59,258,532
21 (5) Community support
22 and grants..... \$ 19,865,281

23 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
24 \$3,776,660 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
25 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
26 nomic Development Fund to the State Parks and Recreation Department for the payment
27 of debt service.

28 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
29 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment
30 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Parks and Recreation De-
31 partment for the following purposes:

- 32 (1) Parks development..... \$ 1,892,853
33 (2) Direct services..... \$ 2,415,941
34 (3) Community support
35 and grants..... \$ 18,493,835

1 **“SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
2 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
3 **July 1, 2021.”.**

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
