

A-Engrossed House Bill 5028

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of State Police for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain moneys or other revenues allocated to Parks and Natural Resources Fund for certain purposes.

Modifies certain biennial appropriation made from General Fund to department.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of State Police; and declaring an emer-

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of State Police, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following**
7 **purposes:**

9 **Investigations, Gaming**
10 **Enforcement and Office of**
11 **the State Fire Marshal \$214,836,486**

12 (2) **Fish and Wildlife**

19 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
20 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**
21 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
22 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State**

25 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
 26 **\$11,068,651 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**
 27 **payment of expenses from moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to**
 28 **the Department of State Police for fish and wildlife enforcement activities.**

29 **SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
 30 **made to the Department of State Police by section 1 (1), chapter 568, Oregon Laws 2019, for**
 31 **the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for patrol services, criminal investigations, gaming**
 32 **enforcement and the office of the State Fire Marshal, is increased by \$268,200 for the state's**
 33 **share of federally reimbursable wildfire expenses incurred during the 2020 wildfires.**

34 **SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
 35 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
 36 **July 1, 2021.**
