10 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$11,068,651 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to the Department of State Police for fish and wildlife enforcement activities.

<sup>14</sup> "<u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation <sup>15</sup> made to the Department of State Police by section 1 (1), chapter 568, Oregon Laws 2019, for <sup>16</sup> the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for patrol services, criminal investigations, gaming <sup>17</sup> enforcement and the office of the State Fire Marshal, is increased by \$268,200 for the state's <sup>18</sup> share of federally reimbursable wildfire expenses incurred during the 2020 wildfires.

"SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect
July 1, 2021.".

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
