

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5036

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Veterans’ Affairs, for the
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
4 following purposes:

6 by the Department of
7 Veterans’ Affairs \$ 6,553,642
8 (2) For payments to counties
9 pursuant to ORS 406.462 \$ 1,954,773
10 (3) For payments to veterans’
11 service organizations
12 pursuant to ORS 406.310 \$ 127,920
13 (4) For debt service \$ 371,660

14 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
15 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment
16 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans’ Services Fund established
17 under ORS 406.140 to the Department of Veterans’ Affairs, for the following purposes:

21 (2) For payments to counties
22 pursuant to ORS 406.462 \$ 7,474,669
23 (3) For payments to veterans’
24 service organizations
25 pursuant to ORS 406.310 \$ 497,880
26 (4) For debt service \$ 690,010

27 “**SECTION 3.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
28 \$115,372,793 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
29 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts
30 and the Oregon War Veterans’ Bond Sinking Account, but excluding lottery funds and fed-
31 eral funds, collected or received by the Department of Veterans’ Affairs for administration,
32 grants and services supplied to veterans.

33 “(2) This section does not limit expenditures from the Oregon War Veterans’ Bond
34 Sinking Account for purposes described in section 5 of this 2021 Act.

35 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of

1 \$1,617,844 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
2 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Veterans'
3 Affairs.

4 **“SECTION 5.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department
5 of Veterans' Affairs for the following purposes are not limited:

6 **“(1) Debt service;**

7 **“(2) Professional services and related costs associated directly with bond sales;**

8 **“(3) Loans to veterans; and**

9 **“(4) Payments on behalf of borrowers for property taxes, city liens, fire insurance,**
10 **mortgage cancellation insurance and repairs to and miscellaneous charges for borrower-**
11 **owned property that are charged to the loan account and repaid along with the payment of**
12 **loan interest and principal.**

13 **“SECTION 6.** This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
14 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect
15 July 1, 2021.”.
