

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5040

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “administration;” insert “amending sections 3, 6, 10, 13, 13a
2 and 16, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 15 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by section 1, chapter 8,
5 Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended to read:

6 “**Sec. 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the
7 Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business Development Depart-
8 ment, for the following purposes:

20 “**SECTION 2.** Section 6, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to read:

21 “**Sec. 6.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the Administrative
22 Services Economic Development Fund, to the office of the Governor, the amount of [~~\$3,932,736~~
23 **\$4,106,514** for expenses of the Regional Solutions Program.

24 “**SECTION 3.** Section 10, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by section 5, chapter 8,
25 Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended to read:

26 “**Sec. 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549 (2) for a percentage-
27 based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, the amount allocated from the
28 Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund is
29 [~~\$14,578,599~~] **\$14,673,344.**

30 “**SECTION 4.** Section 13, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by section 7, chapter 8,
31 Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended to read:

32 “**Sec. 13.** There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the Veterans’ Ser-
33 vices Fund, to the Veterans’ Department of Veterans’ Affairs Dedicated Lottery Fund, the following
34 amounts for the following purposes:

 10 of implementing the provisions of section 1, chapter 528, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill
 11 2202).

12 **"SECTION 6.** Section 16, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by section 8, chapter 8,
 13 Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended to read:

14 **"Sec. 16.** There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the
 15 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for the
 16 following purposes:

21 **"SECTION 7. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
 22 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
 23 **on its passage."**

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
