House Joint Resolution 8

Sponsored by Representative POST; Representative OWENS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require Legislative Assembly, in each oddnumbered year regular session, to appropriate moneys to fund public education in first 60 days of session and before passing any other budget measure.

Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

JOINT RESOLUTION

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

PARAGRAPH 1. The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section 34 to be added to and made a part of Article IV, such section to read:

SECTION 34. (1) Within the first 60 days after the commencement of each odd-numbered year regular session, the Legislative Assembly must pass measures appropriating moneys sufficient to pay for adequate public education, during the biennium beginning July 1 of the year in which the session is held, for students in kindergarten through grade 12.

- (2) Until the measures described in subsection (1) of this section are passed, the Legislative Assembly may not pass any other budget measure.
- (3) As used in this section, "budget measure" means a measure that appropriates moneys or imposes a limitation on expenditures of continuously appropriated moneys and that is prohibited from containing provisions on other subjects under section 7, Article IX of this Constitution.
