SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to study Oregon State Police and report to appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.

Sunsets January 2, 2023.

2 Relating to the Oregon State Police.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall study the**
5 **Oregon State Police and report to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the**
6 **Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.**

7 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**
