Senate Bill 234

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Corrections to consider certain education programs as qualifying programs for purposes of monetary performance reward system offered to adults in custody.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to educational programs for adults in custody.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> To the extent permitted by Article I, section 41, of the Oregon Constitution,

5 the Department of Corrections shall consider an educational program to be a qualifying

6 program for the purposes of any monetary performance reward program offered to adults in

7 custody by the department if:

8 (1) The program consists of training for approved high school equivalency tests such as

9 the General Educational Development (GED), or a post-secondary education program; and

10 (2) The program is approved by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

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
