Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023. "SECTION 3. No later than September 1, 2022, the Department of Corrections shall en-14 sure that adults in custody, in the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility and the Snake River 1516 Correctional Institution, have online access to: 17 "(1) The adult basic skills development program described in ORS 421.084; 18 "(2) The professional and technical program described in ORS 421.081; and 19 "(3) Education programs that provide college credit, a college degree, a college certifica-20 tion, an industry-recognized certification or license or an apprenticeship. 21"SECTION 4. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021 22regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.". 23
