(1) [Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, in every county,] The office of 3 the county clerk in every county shall establish regular business hours to receive and certify, 4 $\mathbf{5}$ as required [by] under ORS 93.620, instruments presented for recording, for a minimum of [six hours between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., including the first hour and the last hour, on every day except 6 7 Saturdays, Sundays and other holidays] four hours per day, and 30 hours per week, from Monday through Friday. 8 9 "(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section: 10 "(a) The county clerk may reduce the number of regular business hours below the mini-11 mums required under subsection (1) of this section for: 12"(A) A holiday recognized by the county governing body; 13 "(B) A state of emergency declared at the local, state or federal level; or 14 "(C) An event that poses a safety risk to the public or staff of the office. 15 "(b) The county clerk may reduce the number of regular weekly business hours to less 16 than 30 for training programs of the office of the county clerk, not to exceed two business 17 day closures per year. 18 "[(2)] (3)(a) [The provisions of this section may be modified for a fiscal year by] Notwithstanding 19 subsection (1) of this section, the county governing body may modify the regular business 20 hours of the office of the county clerk for a fiscal year upon adoption of a resolution in which 21[it] the governing body determines in its sole discretion that a fiscal emergency exists in the 22county. 23"(b) A resolution adopted under this subsection may be renewed, amended or repealed by the 24county governing body. 25"(c) [Hours of recording shall] The regular business hours established under subsection (1) of this section may not be reduced under [the] a resolution to [any] a greater extent [greater] than 2627the [reductions for] regular business hours of other nonemergency county services housed within 28the same building are reduced.". 29
