## Senate Bill 328

## SUMMARY

	Prescribes requirements for annual school district and school performance reports, including requirement for inclusion of data related to suspensions and expulsions.
1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to annual reports related to schools; amending ORS 329.105.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 329.105 is amended to read:
5	329.105. (1) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall collect data and produce annual
6	school district and school performance reports [to provide information to parents and to improve
7	schools]. For the purposes of providing information to parents and improving schools, the
8	reports must be made available in a format in which data can be sorted and in which school
9	districts and schools can be compared with one another.
10	(2) The superintendent shall include in the school district and school performance reports data
11	for the following areas, for each school or district, that are available to the Department of Educa-
12	tion from the most recent school year:
13	(a) Data required by the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (P.L. 114-95, 129 Stat. 1802)[;].
14	(b) Information about how to access the website that is maintained by the State Department of
15	Geology and Mineral Industries as provided by ORS 516.030 (6)(b)[;].
16	(c) Information related to the number of children served in the district and the number of chil-
17	dren who are susceptible to restrictable disease, as reported under ORS 433.269 (2)(a)[; and].
18	(d) Data on suspensions and expulsions, including demographic data based on grade, race,
19	ethnicity, gender, disability status and status as economically disadvantaged, unless the de-
20	mographic data would reveal personally identifiable information about an individual student.
21	The demographic data must be made available as percentages for each demographic group
22	as compared to total percentages for the school district or school.
23	[(d)] (e) Any other data identified by the Department of Education as required by federal law
24	to be in the reports.
25	(3) In addition to the data required by subsection (2) of this section, the superintendent may
26	include other data on the school district and school performance reports.
27	(4) The department shall work with stakeholders to:
28	(a) Design and implement an accountability system of progressive interventions for schools and
29	school districts that do not demonstrate improvement; and
30	(b) Provide technical assistance to schools and school districts that do not demonstrate im-
31	provement.
