

Senate Bill 344

Sponsored by Senator GOLDEN (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Forestry Department to study and make recommendations to interim committee of Legislative Assembly regarding efficacy of prescribed burns.

Sunset January 2, 2023.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to prescribed burns; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State Forestry Department shall study and make recommendations**
5 **concerning the efficacy of prescribed burns.**

6 **(2) The department shall provide the results of the study in a report to an interim com-**
7 **mittee of the Legislative Assembly relating to natural resources, in the manner provided by**
8 **ORS 192.245, no later than September 15, 2022.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021**
11 **regular session of the Eight-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
