

Senate Bill 357

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care for Oregon Recovers)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study issues related to revenue derived from sales of alcoholic beverages, and to report recommendations to Legislative Assembly by September 1, 2022.

Sunsets December 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to revenue derived from sales of alcoholic beverages.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall study issues related to revenue derived from sales of alcoholic beverages, and shall report recommendations to the Legislative Assembly on or before September 1, 2022.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on December 1, 2022.
