

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 386

By COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES, MENTAL HEALTH AND RECOVERY

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “witnesses” insert “; and prescribing an effective date”.

2 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) No later than January 1, 2022, county sheriffs, municipal police depart-**  
4 **ments, police departments established by a university under ORS 352.121 and 353.125 and the**  
5 **Oregon State Police shall develop comprehensive policies regarding parental notification of**  
6 **the interview of a child witness. A policy developed under this section may prioritize child**  
7 **safety, consistent with state and federal law.**

8 **“(2) Each county sheriff, municipal police department and police department established**  
9 **by a university and the Oregon State Police shall submit a report in the manner provided in**  
10 **ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary**  
11 **no later than September 15, 2022, regarding the policies developed under this section.**

12 **“(3) As used in this section, ‘child witness’ means an unmarried person who is under 18**  
13 **years of age and who is not the victim of, suspect in or related to the suspect in a child**  
14 **welfare, criminal or delinquency investigation.**

15 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**

16 **“SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021**  
17 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
