| 6        | "(B) On private property without the written consent of the property owner;                  |
| 7        | "(b) The other person is intimidated or placed in fear of imminent bodily harm by the        |
| 8        | display; and   |
| 9        | "(c) A reasonable person would be intimidated or placed in fear of imminent bodily harm      |
| 10       | by the display.  |
| 11       | "(2) Intimidation by display of a noose is a Class A misdemeanor.                            |
| 12       | "(3) As used in this section:  |
| 13       | "(a) 'Intimidate' means to threaten another person in a manner that compels or deters        |
| 14       | the other person's conduct.  |
| 15       | "(b) 'Noose' means a tied loop in the end of a length of rope or cord.".                     |
