

Senate Bill 41

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that certification of person employed by State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision does not lapse if person meets certain requirements.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2 Relating to employees of the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 181A.355 to**
6 **181A.670.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) The certification of a person employed by the State Board of Parole and**
8 **Post-Prison Supervision does not lapse if:**

9 (a) **The person completes at least 20 hours annually of continuing education approved by**
10 **the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training; and**

11 (b) **The person's certification has not been suspended or revoked under ORS 181A.630,**
12 **181A.640 and 181A.650.**

13 (2) **An employee of the board who is certified as a police officer, certified reserve officer,**
14 **corrections officer, parole and probation officer, fire service professional, telecommunicator**
15 **or emergency medical dispatcher is considered to be employed as a full-time public safety**
16 **officer in the discipline in which certification is held under this section for purposes of de-**
17 **nying, suspending or revoking certification under ORS 181A.630, 181A.640 and 181A.650.**

18 **SECTION 3. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
20 **on its passage.**
