

Senate Bill 414

Sponsored by Senator GORSEK (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to study benefits and feasibility of establishing state office of community livability to foster volunteer cleanup efforts. Requires department to submit report of findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to economic development no later than September 15, 2022. Sunsets January 2, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to community livability.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Business Development Department shall conduct a study of the**
5 **benefits and feasibility of establishing a state office of community livability to foster volun-**
6 **teer cleanup efforts in communities in this state. No later than September 15, 2022, the de-**
7 **partment shall submit a report of the findings of the study to the interim committees of the**
8 **Legislative Assembly related to economic development in the manner provided under ORS**
9 **192.245.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**
