## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 486

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Modifies requirements of plans of instruction for talented and gifted children. Specifies plan availability requirements.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to plans of instruction for talented and gifted children; amending ORS 343.397.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

**SECTION 1.** ORS 343.397 is amended to read:

- 343.397. (1) A school district shall submit to the Superintendent of Public Instruction a written plan of instruction for talented and gifted children. The plan shall include, but not be limited to:
  - [(1)] (a) A statement of school district policy on the education of talented and gifted children;
- [(2)] (b) An assessment of current special programs and services provided by the **school** district for talented and gifted children;
- [(3)] (c) A statement of **school** district goals for providing comprehensive special programs and services and over what span of time the goals will be achieved;
- [(4)] (d) A description of the nature of the special programs and services which will be provided to accomplish the goals; [and]
- (e) A requirement that each talented and gifted child and the child's parents have the opportunity to discuss with the school district the programs and services available to the child and to provide input on the programs and services to be made available to the child;
- [(5)] (f) A plan for evaluating progress on the **school** district plan, including each component program and service[.]; and
- (g) The name and contact information for the school district's coordinator of special educational services and programs for talented and gifted children.
  - (2)(a) For a plan described in subsection (1) of this section, a school district shall:
- (A) Provide the plan when requested at any of the schools of the school district or at the school district's main office; and
  - (B) Provide the plan on the school district's website.
- (b) A school district must provide the name and contact information for the school district's coordinator of special educational services and programs for talented and gifted children:
  - (A) To the Department of Education annually; and
