

Senate Bill 537

Sponsored by Senator GIROD; Senator FINDLEY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals regulation that restricts food and beverage provider or convenience store from providing single-use plastic straws other than at consumer's specific request.
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to single-use plastic straws; repealing ORS 616.892 and 616.894; and prescribing an effective
3 date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 616.892 and 616.894 are repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021**
7 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
