

Senate Bill 547

Sponsored by Senator GIROD; Senator FINDLEY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires public body that declares riot or civil disturbance to pay peace officers double regular pay for responding to riot or civil disturbance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to compensation of peace officers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. When a public body declares a riot or civil disturbance, the public body shall**
5 **pay a peace officer, as defined in ORS 161.015, who is employed by the public body and re-**
6 **sponds to the riot or civil disturbance double the regular hourly pay of the peace officer for**
7 **the time spent responding to the riot or civil disturbance.**
