**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

**Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Energy for certain biennial expenses.**

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [*State Department of Energy*] **department.**

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Energy; and declaring an emer-  
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Department of Energy, for the biennium**  
6 **beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$80,092 for oversight of ra-**  
7 **dioactive waste disposal.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
9 **\$31,011,546 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**  
10 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
11 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department**  
12 **of Energy.**

13 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
14 **\$3,022,570 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**  
15 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**  
16 **nomic Development Fund to the State Department of Energy for debt service for the energy**  
17 **efficiency and sustainable technology loan program, and for the public schools grant pro-**  
18 **gram.**

19 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
20 **\$3,123,736 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**  
21 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of**  
22 **Energy.**

23 **SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the following expenditures by the**

1 **State Department of Energy are not limited:**

4 **SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
5 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**  
6 **July 1, 2021.**

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
