17 **“SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
18 **\$36,940,110** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
19 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
20 **nomic Development Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for debt service**
21 **on lottery bonds sold for the benefit of Oregon public universities.**

22 **“SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
23 **\$13,379,130** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
24 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
25 **nomic Development Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for debt service**
26 **on lottery bonds sold for the benefit of Oregon community colleges.**

27 **“SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
28 **\$12,274,716** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
29 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Education Stability Fund to the**
30 **Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Oregon Opportunity Grants.**

31 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
32 **\$49,418,728** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
33 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
34 **nomic Development Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to the Outdoor**
35 **School Education Fund.**

36 **“SECTION 5a.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
37 **\$16,514,607** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
38 **payment of expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from lottery moneys**
39 **allocated to the Sports Lottery Account.**

40 **“SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
41 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**
42 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
43 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds and funds described in sections 8 to 12 of this 2021**
44 **Act, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the follow-**
45 **ing purposes:**

- 2 **Commission programs and**
- 3 **related grants \$ 77,211,231**
- 4 **(2) Debt service on outstanding**
- 5 **general obligation bonds sold**
- 6 **for the benefit of Oregon**
- 7 **Health and Science University.. \$ 30,869,380**
- 8 **(3) Debt service on outstanding**
- 9 **lottery bonds and general**
- 10 **obligation bonds sold for**
- 11 **the benefit of Oregon public**
- 12 **universities \$ 4,101,340**

13 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**

14 **\$130,656,715 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**

15 **payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 10 of**

16 **this 2021 Act, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for**

17 **Higher Education Coordinating Commission programs and related grants.**

18 **“SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$70,563**

19 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of**

20 **expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from the moneys received from**

21 **the Western Oregon Timber Severance Tax Fund and the Eastern Oregon Timber Severance**

22 **Tax Fund for the Community College Support Fund.**

23 **“SECTION 9. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Higher Edu-**

24 **cation Coordinating Commission for debt service on general obligation bonds and certificates**

25 **of participation issued for the benefit of public universities and Oregon Health and Science**

26 **University and paid with resources received from the public universities and Oregon Health**

27 **and Science University are not limited.**

28 **“SECTION 10. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Higher Edu-**

29 **cation Coordinating Commission for payments to individuals, organizations or units of gov-**

30 **ernment from federal National Emergency Grants funds are not limited.**

31 **“SECTION 11. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Higher Edu-**

32 **cation Coordinating Commission for debt service on Build America Bonds sold for the benefit**

33 **of public universities and community colleges are not limited.**

34 **“SECTION 12. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Higher Edu-**

35 **cation Coordinating Commission of moneys from the Tuition Protection Fund are not limited.**

36 **“SECTION 13. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**

37 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**

38 **July 1, 2021.”.**
