¹⁹ "<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the ²⁰ General Fund, the amount of \$15,859,656, to be allocated to the Department of Human Ser-²² vices for positions to reduce the number of double-fill positions associated with the child ²³ welfare program.

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated 24 25by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2022, the moneys remaining on that date be-26come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds. 27"SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$24,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for 28 29payment of expenses by the Department of Human Services from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Ad-30 ministrative Services and transferred to the Department of Human Services, for long-term 31care workforce development and training and the capital improvement and emergency 3233 preparedness program.

"<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect
July 1, 2021.".

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
