

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5533

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 25

1       On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 24 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

2       “**SECTION 1.** During the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, all lottery revenues available  
3 to benefit the public purposes specified in Article XV, section 4, of the Oregon Constitution,  
4 that are in excess of distributions or allocations required by law shall be maintained in the  
5 Administrative Services Economic Development Fund.

6       “**SECTION 2.** All moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund as  
7 of July 1, 2021, and thereafter are reserved to meet the commitments of sections 1 to 13 of  
8 this 2021 Act.

9       “**SECTION 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1,  
10 2021, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business  
11 Development Department, for the following purposes:

- 12       (1) Operations..... \$ 10,938,127  
13       (2) Business, innovation  
14             and trade..... \$ 83,591,268  
15       (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 4,384,506  
16       (4) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,419,830

17       “**SECTION 4.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Ad-  
18 ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Department of Education, for the  
19 State School Fund, the amount of \$589,526,746.

20       “**SECTION 5.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Ad-  
21 ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the office of the Governor, the  
22 amount of \$4,552,709 for expenses of the Regional Solutions Program.

23       “**SECTION 6.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish a  
24 process for allocating available moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Develop-  
25 ment Fund on a quarterly basis to fulfill the biennial allocations made by sections 1 to 13 of  
26 this 2021 Act. The department shall set the quarterly allocations.

27       “(2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Ad-  
28 ministrative Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly  
29 allocations made by sections 1 to 13 of this 2021 Act or any other 2021 Act, prior to making  
30 any other allocations pursuant to sections 1 to 13 of this 2021 Act, the department shall  
31 satisfy lottery bond debt service obligations in the amount of \$278,511,961 for outstanding  
32 lottery bonds.

33       “(3) After the lottery bond debt service obligations described in subsection (2) of this  
34 section are satisfied, if the remaining moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to  
35 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the

1 quarterly allocations made by sections 1 to 13 of this 2021 Act, the department shall reduce  
2 the quarterly allocations not described in subsection (2) of this section proportionately in  
3 amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

4 **“SECTION 7.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Ad-  
5 ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Department of Adminis-  
6 trative Services, the amount of \$278,511,961 for the purpose of paying, when due, the  
7 principal, interest and premium, if any, on outstanding lottery bonds, as described in section  
8 6 of this 2021 Act.

9 **“SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.547 (1) for a  
10 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the amount  
11 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon De-  
12 partment of Administrative Services for distribution to counties for economic development  
13 activities as provided by ORS 461.547 is \$54,209,527.

14 **“SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549 (2) for a  
15 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the amount  
16 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Problem  
17 Gambling Treatment Fund is \$16,514,510.

18 **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 565.447 for a  
19 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the amount  
20 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the County Fair  
21 Account established in ORS 565.445 is \$3,828,000.

22 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the allocation described in section 2 (3),  
23 chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 99 (2016)), for a percentage-based transfer of  
24 moneys with an annual cap, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the amount allocated  
25 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Outdoor School Edu-  
26 cation Fund is \$49,418,728.

27 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.543 (4) for a  
28 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the amount  
29 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Sports Lot-  
30 tery Account is \$16,514,607.

31 **“SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the allocation described in section 44,  
32 chapter 355, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by section 1, chapter 10, Oregon Laws 2021, for  
33 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the amount allocated from the Administrative Services  
34 Economic Development Fund to the Employer Incentive Fund is \$12,665,769.

35 **“SECTION 14.** There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the  
36 Veterans’ Services Fund, to the Veterans’ Department of Veterans’ Affairs Dedicated Lot-  
37 tery Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- 38 (1) Veterans’ Services Program ..... \$ 12,628,046
- 39 (2) County Veterans’ Service  
40 Officers ..... \$ 7,474,669
- 41 (3) National Service  
42 Organizations ..... \$ 497,880

43 **“SECTION 14a.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the  
44 Veterans’ Services Fund, to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, the amount of \$261,416 for  
45 veterans’ employment apprenticeship outreach and coordination.

1       “**SECTION 14b.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the  
2 Veterans’ Services Fund, to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, the amount of \$578,865  
3 for veterans’ specialty courts.

4       “**SECTION 14c.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the  
5 Veterans’ Services Fund, to the Oregon Health Authority, the amount of \$2,127,476 for  
6 veterans’ behavioral health services.

7       “**SECTION 15.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish a  
8 process for allocating available moneys in the Veterans’ Services Fund on a quarterly basis  
9 to fulfill the biennial allocations made by sections 14 to 14c of this 2021 Act.

10       “(2) If the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Veterans’ Services  
11 Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations under subsection (1) of this section,  
12 the department shall reduce the quarterly allocations proportionately in amounts sufficient  
13 to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

14       “**SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the  
15 Department of Revenue shall distribute the moneys in the Criminal Fine Account established  
16 by ORS 137.300 as specified in sections 17 to 21 of this 2021 Act.

17       “**SECTION 17.** There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and  
18 Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the fol-  
19 lowing amounts for the following purposes:

- 20       (1) Criminal justice training  
21             and standards operations..... \$ 43,257,427
- 22       (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund ... \$ 279,677

23       “**SECTION 18.** There are allocated to the Department of Justice for the biennium begin-  
24 ning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for the following  
25 purposes:

- 26       (1) Child Abuse Multidisciplinary  
27             Intervention Account..... \$ 11,694,249
- 28       (2) Creation and operation of a  
29             statewide system of regional  
30             assessment centers as  
31             provided under ORS 418.746  
32             to 418.796..... \$ 883,388
- 33       (3) Criminal Injuries  
34             Compensation Account ..... \$ 9,846,982
- 35       (4) Services to children eligible  
36             for compensation under  
37             ORS 147.390 and costs to  
38             administer provision of  
39             these services ..... \$ 747,739

40       “**SECTION 19.** There are allocated to the Department of Human Services for the  
41 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for  
42 the following purposes:

- 43       (1) Domestic Violence Fund  
44             established in ORS 409.300  
45             for the purpose of

1           ORS 409.292 (1)(a) to (c)..... \$ 2,320,336  
2           (2) Sexual Assault Victims Fund... \$ 556,265

3           “**SECTION 20.** There are allocated to the State Court Facilities and Security Account  
4 established under ORS 1.178, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine  
5 Account, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- 6           (1) State court security  
7                 and emergency preparedness.... \$ 4,147,778  
8           (2) Distributions to county court  
9                 facilities security accounts..... \$ 3,057,584

10          “**SECTION 21.** (1) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium  
11 beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$42,884 for the pur-  
12 pose of grants under ORS 430.345 for the establishment, operation and maintenance of alco-  
13 hol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment services provided through  
14 a county.

15          “(2) There is allocated to the Law Enforcement Medical Liability Account established  
16 under ORS 414.815, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account,  
17 the amount of \$1,300,000.

18          “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon State Police for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021,  
19 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$351,572 for the purpose of enforcing the laws  
20 relating to driving under the influence of intoxicants.

21          “(4) There is allocated to the Department of Corrections for the biennium beginning July  
22 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$4,846,812 for the purpose of plan-  
23 ning, operating and maintaining county juvenile and adult corrections programs and facilities  
24 and drug and alcohol programs. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300 (4), the grant to each county  
25 shall be based on the formula used to determine the distribution of moneys under the  
26 Grant-in-Aid Program under ORS 423.530.

27          “(5) There is allocated to the State Court Technology Fund established under ORS 1.012,  
28 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of  
29 \$3,887,500.

30          “(6) There is allocated to the Intoxicated Driver Program Fund created under ORS  
31 813.270, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount  
32 of \$4,323,000.

33          “(7) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium beginning July  
34 1, 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$331,824 for the Emergency Medical  
35 Services and Trauma Systems Program created under ORS 431A.085.

36          “(8) There is allocated to the Department of Revenue for the biennium beginning July 1,  
37 2021, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$100,000 for administrative costs of the  
38 department.

39          “**SECTION 22.** After distributing the amounts specified in sections 17 to 21 of this 2021  
40 Act, the Department of Revenue shall distribute funds remaining in the Criminal Fine Ac-  
41 count to the General Fund.

42          “**SECTION 23.** (1) There is allocated to the State School Fund established under ORS  
43 327.008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the  
44 amount of \$36,000,000.

45          “(2) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for mental health treatment or

1 for purposes related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment  
2 services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the  
3 amount of \$18,000,000.

4 “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the health systems division,  
5 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount  
6 of \$4,500,000 for purposes related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention  
7 and treatment services.

8 “(4) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July  
9 1, 2021, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$249,360,000, for deposit into the  
10 Drug Treatment and Recovery Services Fund.

11 “(5) There is allocated to the State Police Account established under ORS 181A.020, for  
12 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of  
13 \$13,500,000.

14 “SECTION 24. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect  
16 July 1, 2021.”

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
