

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5539

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
3 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**
4 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
5 **cluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in section 2 of this 2021 Act, collected**
6 **or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:**

- 7 (1) **Common School Fund**
- 8 **programs..... \$ 40,779,060**
- 9 (2) **Submerged Lands**
- 10 **Enhancement Fund..... \$ 200,000**
- 11 (3) **South Slough National**
- 12 **Estuarine Research**
- 13 **Reserve operations..... \$ 2,642,051**
- 14 (4) **Capital improvements \$ 549,056**
- 15 (5) **Oregon Wetlands**
- 16 **Revolving Fund \$ 2,048,739**

17 “**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
18 **\$5,249,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**
19 **payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup**
20 **Fund established by ORS 274.064.**

21 “**SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
22 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**
23 **of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for**
24 **the following purposes:**

- 25 (1) **South Slough National**
- 26 **Estuarine Research**
- 27 **Reserve operations..... \$ 2,738,001**
- 28 (2) **Common School Fund**
- 29 **programs..... \$ 195,954**

30 “**SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department**
31 **of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges, unclaimed property finders fees and State**
32 **Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.**

33 “**SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
34 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
35 **July 1, 2021.”.**
