

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 578

By COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY AND BALLOT MEASURE 110 IMPLEMENTATION

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 31 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

3 **“(a) ‘Case subtype’ means guardianship, conservatorship or guardianship and conserva-**
4 **torship.**

5 **“(b) ‘Case type’ means adult protective proceeding or minor protective proceeding.**

6 **“(2) No later than September 15 of each year, the Judicial Department shall submit, to**
7 **the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary, a report on**
8 **county-level data concerning protective proceedings in Multnomah, Lane and Columbia**
9 **Counties during the two calendar years immediately preceding the year of the report, in-**
10 **cluding:**

11 **“(a) The number of protective proceedings initiated, broken out by case type and case**
12 **subtype;**

13 **“(b) The number of protective proceedings where the respondent was 65 years of age or**
14 **older at the time the petition was filed;**

15 **“(c) The number of protective proceedings granted, broken out by case type and case**
16 **subtype; and**

17 **“(d) The number of respondents or protected persons for whom the court appointed**
18 **counsel under ORS 125.080, broken out by case subtype.**

19 **“(3) The department, in consultation with the office of public defense services, shall also**
20 **include in the report described in subsection (2) of this section, to the extent the data is**
21 **available:**

22 **“(a) The number of cases with court appointed counsel where payment for court ap-**
23 **pointed counsel was from the assets of the respondent or protected person, broken out by**
24 **case subtype; and**

25 **“(b) The aggregate number of hours court appointed counsel spent representing re-**
26 **spondents or protected persons and the average number of hours court appointed counsel**
27 **spent per case.**

28 **“SECTION 3. The Judicial Department shall submit the first report required under sec-**
29 **tion 2 of this 2021 Act no later than September 15, 2024, and annually thereafter.**

30 **“SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 125.080 by section 1 of this 2021 Act apply only to:**

31 **“(1) Hearings taking place in Multnomah County and Lane County on or after January**
32 **2, 2022;**

33 **“(2) Hearings taking place in Columbia County on or after January 2, 2023; and**

34 **“(3) Hearings taking place in any other county on or after January 2, 2024.”**

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
