

Senate Bill 592

Sponsored by Senator FREDERICK (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits person from using lead weight in waters of this state for purpose of angling or commercial fishing. Provides that violation is punishable by maximum of 364 days' imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

Prohibits person from using lead shotgun pellet for purpose of hunting. Provides that violation is punishable by maximum of 364 days' imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

2 Relating to lead contamination.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A person may not use a lead weight in the waters of this state for the**
5 **purpose of angling or commercial fishing.**

6 **(2) A person that violates subsection (1) of this section commits a Class A misdemeanor.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) A person may not use a lead shotgun pellet for the purpose of hunting.**

8 **(2) A person who violates subsection (1) of this section commits a Class A misdemeanor.**
