

Senate Bill 621

Sponsored by Senator FREDERICK (at the request of City of Portland) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Upholds, under certain circumstances, local laws concerning local community oversight board established to oversee disciplinary matters concerning law enforcement officers, notwithstanding collective bargaining laws that require bargaining over such matters.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to effect of collective bargaining laws on local laws; amending ORS 243.772.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 243.772 is amended to read:

5 243.772. (1) Any provisions of local charters and ordinances adopted pursuant thereto in exist-
6 ence on October 5, 1973, and not in conflict with the rights and duties established in ORS 240.060,
7 240.065, 240.080, 240.123, 243.650 to 243.806 and 341.290 may remain in full force and effect after the
8 Employment Relations Board has determined that no conflict exists.

9 **(2) Notwithstanding ORS 243.650 (4) and (7)(a) and subsection (1) of this section, any**
10 **provisions of a city charter or ordinance that relate to the establishment of a local commu-**
11 **nity oversight board created to oversee disciplinary matters concerning law enforcement of-**
12 **ficers, as defined in ORS 131.930, shall remain in full force and effect provided that:**

13 **(a) A measure that included the question of whether to establish the local community**
14 **oversight board was referred to the people of the city at an election held on or after July 1,**
15 **2020; and**

16 **(b) A majority of voters voting on the measure voted in favor of the establishment of the**
17 **board.**
