

# Senate Bill 669

Sponsored by Senator GORSEK (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires certain mass transit and transportation districts to be registered apprenticeship training agents as condition of receiving distributions from Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to apprenticeship.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 184.752 to**  
5 **184.766.**

6 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 184.758, the Oregon Transportation Commission may**  
7 **not distribute moneys in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund to a mass transit**  
8 **district or transportation district with a population of 500,000 or more unless the mass**  
9 **transit district or transportation district is a training agent, as defined in ORS 660.010, at**  
10 **the time of the distribution.**
