CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to substance abuse treatment; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Rules adopted by the Oregon Health Authority, in accordance with ORS 430.357, establishing requirements for the approval of an opioid treatment center to operate in this state must include a requirement that an opioid treatment center accept Medicare payments as reimbursement for the cost of covered services provided by the center.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021 session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
