

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 749

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 23

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 41, insert:

2 “(d) The date of the referral agent’s last visit to the facility and whether the visit was in person  
3 or a virtual tour as permitted under subsection (2)(b) of this section.”.

4 Delete line 45.

5 On page 3, delete line 1 and insert:

6 “(b) Refer a client to a residential care program unless within the prior 24 months, the agent  
7 has personally toured the program or, if the tour occurred during a time when personal tours were  
8 prohibited by a federal, state or local emergency declaration, virtually toured the program.”.

9 In line 41, delete “\$750” and insert “\$325”.

10 In line 43, delete “\$750” and insert “\$325”.

11 On page 6, after line 27, insert:

12 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**  
13 **made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021**  
14 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 5529), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, for state assessments**  
15 **and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$467,993, which may be expended for carrying out**  
16 **the provisions of this 2021 Act.**

17 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
18 **expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021 (Enrolled Senate**  
19 **Bill 5529), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of**  
20 **expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medi-**  
21 **care receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supple-**  
22 **mental Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding**  
23 **lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021**  
24 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 5529), collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for**  
25 **state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$10,660 for the purpose of car-**  
26 **rying out the provisions of this 2021 Act.**

27 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
28 **expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021 (Enrolled Senate**  
29 **Bill 5529), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of**  
30 **expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medi-**  
31 **care receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supple-**  
32 **mental Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding**  
33 **lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021**  
34 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 5529), collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for**  
35 **shared services, is increased by \$628,913 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this**

1 **2021 Act.**

2 **“SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
3 **expenditures established by section 3 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021 (Enrolled Senate**  
4 **Bill 5529), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-**  
5 **penses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon**  
6 **Laws 2021 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5529), collected or received by the Department of Human**  
7 **Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$253,709 for the**  
8 **purpose of carrying out the provisions of this 2021 Act.”.**

9 In line 28, delete “5” and insert “9”.

10 In line 35, delete “6” and insert “10”.

11 In line 37, delete “7” and insert “11”.

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
