Senate Bill 78

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on best methods for coordinating activities among Oregon's post-secondary institutions of education during periods of economic recession in manner that best promotes public interest. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to higher education; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall conduct a study

5 and develop recommendations on the best methods for coordinating activities among

6 Oregon's post-secondary institutions of education during periods of economic recession in a

7 manner that best promotes the public interest.

8 (2) The commission shall submit a report detailing the recommendations developed under

9 subsection (1) of this section to the legislative committees responsible for higher education
10 during the 2022 regular session of the Legislative Assembly.

11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on June 30, 2022.

12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021 13 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.

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
