## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 554

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 21, insert:

"SECTION 1a. (1) Any entity that adopts an ordinance or policy 2 under section 1 of this 2021 Act limiting or precluding the use of the 3 affirmative defense described in ORS 166.370 (3)(g), concerning the 4 possession of firearms by persons licensed to carry a concealed 5 handgun under ORS 166.291 and 166.292, in a public building under the 6 control of the entity is strictly liable for any harm resulting from a 7 violent event that occurs on or near the premises of the public build-8 ing. 9

"(2) The following persons may bring a cause of action under this
section:

12 "(a) A person who is a victim of the violent event; and

"(b) A person who is personally acquainted with a victim of the vi olent event.

"(3) In an action under this section, the defendant is liable unless
the defendant proves, beyond a reasonable doubt, that the plaintiff has

"(4) Upon prevailing in an action under this section, the plaintiff
may recover the greater of:
