**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2513**

1 Delete lines 4 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 181A.440 is amended to read:

3 **“181A.440. (1)** The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training
4 shall include in the minimum training required for basic certification as a
5 police officer under ORS 181A.490:

6 **“[(1)] (a)** The law, theory, policies and practices related to vehicle pursuit
7 driving and, as facilities and funding permit, vehicle pursuit training
8 exercises[; *and*].

9 **“[(2)] (b)** At least 24 hours of training in the recognition of mental ill-
10 nesses utilizing a crisis intervention training model, at least one hour of
11 which must include training on the appropriate use of the medical health
12 database described in ORS 181A.285.

13 **“(c) At least three hours of training in airway and circulatory
14 anatomy and physiology.**

15 **“(d) Certification in adult and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation.**

16 **“(2) The department shall ensure that all police officers certified
17 by the department receive the following training each year:**

18 **“(a) At least two hours of training in airway and circulatory anat-
19 omy and physiology.**

20 **“(b) Certification in adult and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation.**

21 **“SECTION 2. Within 60 seconds after a peace officer, as defined in**

1 **ORS 161.015, encounters a restrained person suffering a respiratory or**
2 **cardiac compromise, the officer shall request emergency medical ser-**
3 **vices if:**

4 **“(1) It is tactically feasible to request emergency medical services;**
5 **and**

6 **“(2) The officer has access to communications.”.**
