**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2518**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, before the period insert “; and pre-
2 scribing an effective date”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 43 and 44 and insert:

4 “(a) The brownfield is in a location identified in an electric vehicle
5 infrastructure plan developed by the Department of Transportation and will
6 be operated as a publicly accessible charging station for electric vehicles
7 immediately after completion.”.

8 On page 3, delete lines 19 through 26 and insert:

9 “(f) The brownfield is a developed site that became a brownfield as a di-
10 rect result of wildfire.”.

11 On page 4, delete lines 35 through 44 and insert:

12 **“SECTION 6. The Oregon Business Development Department shall**
13 **establish by rule the procedures and criteria for administration of the**
14 **program established under sections 2 to 7 of this 2021 Act, including,**
15 **but not limited to, the methods of determining:**

16 **“(1) The distribution of forgivable loans;**

17 **“(2) The amount of a forgivable loan, including enhancements listed**
18 **in section 3 (3) of this 2021 Act;**

19 **“(3) The terms of forgivable loan enhancements under section 3 (3)**
20 **of this 2021 Act;**

21 **“(4) The conditions attached to a loan;**

1 “(5) The circumstances in which forgivable loans must be repaid
2 under section 5 of this 2021 Act; and

3 “(6) Any means by which noncompliance with applicable perform-
4 ance or other conditions attached to a loan may be cured by the owner
5 or operator.”.

6 On page 5, delete lines 18 through 26 and insert:

7 “SECTION 8. (1) The Oregon Business Development Department
8 shall consider means by which the department can encourage partic-
9 ipation in removal and remedial actions that are eligible for forgivable
10 loans under sections 2 to 7 of this 2021 Act by minority-owned busi-
11 nesses, woman-owned businesses and emerging small businesses as
12 those terms are defined in ORS 200.005.

13 “(2) No later than January 1, 2023, the department shall submit a
14 report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 to the interim commit-
15 tees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development that
16 sets forth in detail the recipients of forgivable loans under section 5
17 of this 2021 Act and any third parties with which the recipients con-
18 tracted to complete the removal and remedial actions with respect to
19 which the forgivable loans were made.”.

20 After line 30, insert:

21 “SECTION 11. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
22 date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative
23 Assembly adjourns sine die.”.

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
