**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2927**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 12, delete “476.515,”.

2 On page 7, delete lines 6 through 39 and insert:

3 “**NOTE:** Section 17 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were  
4 not renumbered.”.

5 On page 11, delete lines 41 through 45.

6 On page 12, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:

7 “**NOTE:** Section 23 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were  
8 not renumbered.”.

9 On page 50, after line 38, insert:

10 “**SECTION 88a.** ORS 433.441 is amended to read:

11 “433.441. (1) Upon the occurrence of a public health emergency, the Gov-  
12 ernor may declare a state of public health emergency as authorized by ORS  
13 433.441 to 433.452 to protect the public health.

14 “(2) A [*proclamation*] **declaration** of a state of public health emergency  
15 must specify:

16 “(a) The nature of the public health emergency;

17 “(b) The political subdivision or geographic area subject to the [*procla-*  
18 *mation*] **declaration**;

19 “(c) The conditions that have brought about the public health emergency;  
20 and

21 “(d) The duration of the state of public health emergency, if the duration

1 is less than 14 days.

2 “(3) During a **declared** public health emergency, the Governor may:

3 “(a) Close, order the evacuation of or **order** the decontamination of any  
4 facility the Governor has reasonable cause to believe may endanger the  
5 public health.

6 “(b) Regulate or restrict by any means necessary the use, sale or distrib-  
7 ution of food, fuel, medical supplies, medicines or other goods and services.

8 “(c) Prescribe modes of transportation, routes and destinations required  
9 for the evacuation of individuals or the provision of emergency services.

10 “(d) Control or limit entry into, exit from, movement within and the oc-  
11 cupancy of premises in any public area subject to or threatened by a public  
12 health emergency if such actions are reasonable and necessary to respond to  
13 the public health emergency.

14 “(e) Authorize pharmacists licensed under ORS chapter 689 to administer  
15 vaccines to persons who are three years of age or older.

16 “(f) Take any other action that may be necessary for the management of  
17 resources, or to protect the public during a public health emergency, in-  
18 cluding any actions authorized under ORS 401.168, 401.185, 401.188 and  
19 401.192.

20 “(4) Nothing in ORS 433.441 to 433.452 limits the authority of the Gover-  
21 nor to declare a state of emergency under ORS 401.165. If a state of emer-  
22 gency is declared as authorized under ORS 401.165, the Governor may  
23 implement any action authorized by ORS 433.441 to 433.452.

24 “(5) A [*proclamation*] **declaration** of a state of public health emergency  
25 expires when terminated by a declaration of the Governor or no more than  
26 14 days after the date the public health emergency is [*proclaimed*] **declared**  
27 unless the Governor expressly extends the [*proclamation*] **declaration** for an  
28 additional 14-day period.

29 “(6) When real or personal property is taken under power granted by this  
30 section, the owner of the property shall be entitled to reasonable compen-

1 sation from the state.”.
