**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 5040**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “administration;” insert “amending  
2 sections 3, 6, 10, 13, 13a and 16, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 15 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by  
5 section 1, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended  
6 to read:

7 **“Sec. 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning  
8 July 1, 2019, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund,  
9 to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:

3 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the office of the  
4 Governor, the amount of [~~\$3,932,736~~] **\$4,106,514** for expenses of the Regional  
5 Solutions Program.

6 “**SECTION 3.** Section 10, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by  
7 section 5, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended  
8 to read:

9 “**Sec. 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549  
10 (2) for a percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning  
11 July 1, 2019, the amount allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-  
12 nomic Development Fund to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund is

4 **“SECTION 6.** Section 16, chapter 670, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by  
5 section 8, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2020 (second special session), is amended  
6 to read:

7 **“Sec. 16.** There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Stan-  
8 dards and Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the Crim-  
9 inal Fine Account, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- 10 (1) Criminal justice training  
11 [*and standards operations..... \$ 29,817,371*]  
12 **and standards operations..... \$ 32,985,769**  
13 (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund ..... \$ 279,495

14 **“SECTION 7. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
15 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
16 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
