PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2379

"(5)(a) The first 25,000 feet, board measure, of timber harvested annually by any taxpayer during each calendar year, regardless of the species or variety of the trees, shall be excluded from the total quantity of timber subject to the tax imposed under this section.

"(e) 7.5 percent to each rural fire protection district that has an annual budget of less than \$50 million, in the proportion that the total acreage of forestland within the boundaries of the district bears to the total acreage of forestland within the boundaries of all rural fire protection districts described in this paragraph.

"(f) 7.5 percent to the Watershed Conservation Grant Fund established under ORS 541.947.".
