## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 386

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "witnesses" insert "; and prescribing an effective date".

3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) No later than January 1, 2022, county sheriffs, 4 municipal police departments, police departments established by a 5university under ORS 352.121 and 353.125 and the Oregon State Police 6 shall develop comprehensive policies regarding parental notification 7 of the interview of a child witness. A policy developed under this sec-8 tion may prioritize child safety, consistent with state and federal law. 9 "(2) Each county sheriff, municipal police department and police 10 department established by a university and the Oregon State Police 11 shall submit a report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 to the 12 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judici-13 ary no later than September 15, 2022, regarding the policies developed 14 under this section. 15

16 "(3) As used in this section, 'child witness' means an unmarried 17 person who is under 18 years of age and who is not the victim of, 18 suspect in or related to the suspect in a child welfare, criminal or de-19 linquency investigation.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2,
2023.

"SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative
Assembly adjourns sine die.".
