**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2498**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “vehicles;” delete the rest of  
2 the line and insert “amending ORS 803.370, 803.500 and 807.110.”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 30 through 36 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 3.** ORS 807.110 is amended to read:

5 “807.110. (1) A driver license issued by the Department of Transportation  
6 shall contain all of the following:

7 “(a) The distinguishing number assigned to the person issued the driver  
8 license by the department.

9 “(b) For the purpose of identification, a brief description of the person to  
10 whom the driver license is issued.

11 “(c) The full legal name of the person to whom the driver license is is-  
12 sued, except that the department may limit the number of characters dis-  
13 played on the driver license.

14 “(d) The date of birth and sex of the person to whom the driver license  
15 is issued.

16 “(e) Except as provided for corrections officers in ORS 802.253, eligible  
17 employees in ORS 802.250 or Address Confidentiality Program participants  
18 in ORS 192.846, the residence address of the person to whom the driver li-  
19 cense is issued.

20 “(f) Upon request of the person to whom the driver license is issued, the  
21 fact that the person is an anatomical donor.

1 “(g) Upon request of the person to whom the driver license is issued and  
2 presentation of proof, as determined by the department, the fact that the  
3 person is a veteran, as defined in ORS 408.225.

4 “(h) Upon order of the juvenile court, the fact that the person to whom  
5 the driver license is issued is an emancipated minor.

6 “(i) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this section, a pho-  
7 tograph described in this paragraph. A photograph required under this par-  
8 agraph shall:

9 “(A) Be a full-faced, color photograph of the person to whom the driver  
10 license is issued;

11 “(B) Be of a size approved by the department; and

12 “(C) Be taken at the time of application for issuance of the driver license  
13 whether the application is for an original driver license, replacement of a  
14 driver license under ORS 807.160 or renewal of a driver license under ORS  
15 807.150, except that the department, by rule, may allow the applicant to use  
16 a photograph already on file with the department.

17 “(j) The class of driver license issued and any endorsements granted.

18 “(k) The signature of the person to whom the driver license is issued.

19 “(L) If the driver license is not a Real ID, a design differentiating it from  
20 a Real ID.

21 **“(m) Upon request of the person to whom the driver license is is-  
22 sued, the fact that the person is deaf or hard of hearing.**

23 “(2) The department may issue a valid driver license, other than a com-  
24 mercial driver license, without a photograph to an applicant:

25 “(a) Who objects on religious grounds;

26 “(b) Who objects because of the applicant’s facial disfigurement; or

27 “(c) Who is stationed outside of this state while serving in the active  
28 military service in the Armed Forces of the United States or the National  
29 Guard, and the department does not have an acceptable photograph of the  
30 applicant, as determined by the department by rule. This paragraph applies

1 to an applicant who is renewing or replacing a driver license.

2 “(3) A limited term driver license or a limited term commercial driver li-  
3 cense issued under ORS 807.730 shall indicate:

4 “(a) That it is a limited term driver license; and

5 “(b) The date on which the limited term driver license expires.

6 “(4) The department shall use security procedures, processes and materials  
7 in the preparation, manufacture and issuance of any driver license that pro-  
8 hibit as nearly as possible anyone’s ability to alter, counterfeit, duplicate or  
9 modify the driver license without ready detection. The security features used  
10 in the production of the driver licenses shall provide for:

11 “(a) The authentication of a genuine document in a reasonable time; and

12 “(b) The production of the driver license only by equipment that requires  
13 verification of the identity of the operator of the equipment before a driver  
14 license may be produced.”.

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
