"(iii) Permit a student to wear religious clothing in accordance with the
student's sincerely held religious belief and consistent with any safety and
health requirements;".

6 On page 2, line 44, delete "and".

7 After line 44, insert:

"(ii) Reasonably accommodates the ability of an individual to wear religious clothing in accordance with the individual's sincerely held religious
beliefs; and".

In line 45, delete "(ii)" and insert "(iii)".

12 On page 5, delete lines 30 through 34 and insert:

"(5) This section does not prohibit an employer from enforcing an otherwise valid dress code or policy, if:

"(a) The employer provides, on a case-by-case basis, for reasonable ac commodation of an individual based on the health and safety needs of the
 individual;

"(b) The employer reasonably accommodates the ability of an employee
to wear religious clothing in accordance with the employee's sincerely held
religious beliefs as provided in ORS 659A.033; and

21 "(c) The dress code or policy does not have a disproportionate adverse

- 1 impact on members of a protected class to a greater extent than the policy
