- "(1) Three full-time equivalent positions for the department's function as the state approving agency for veterans' education and training;
- 9 "(2) One full-time equivalent position for campus veterans pro-10 gramming; and
- "(3) One full-time equivalent position for the Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program established under section 1, chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019.
- "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ to carry out the provisions of section 1 of this 2021 Act.
