**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 755**

1 On page 14 of the printed bill, delete lines 31 through 45.

2 On page 15, delete lines 1 through 22 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 22.** Section 22, chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2021 (Ballot Measure
4 110 (2020)), is amended to read:

5 **“Sec. 22. Notwithstanding ORS 153.018,** any person subject to the pen-
6 alty [*set forth in ORS 153.018 (2)(e)*] for a violation that has been classified
7 or reclassified as a Class E violation [*pursuant to section 11 to section 19,*]
8 **under ORS 475.752, 475.824, 475.834, 475.854, 475.874, 475.884 or 475.894**
9 **shall be fined up to \$100, but in lieu of the fine[,] may complete a health**
10 **assessment, as set forth in section 2 [(2)(b)(ii),] (2)(c)(B), chapter 2, Oregon**
11 **Laws 2021 (Ballot Measure 110 (2020)), at an Addiction Recovery Center.**
12 Upon verification that the person has received a health assessment at an
13 Addiction Recovery Center within 45 days of when the person receives a ci-
14 tation for a violation subject to the penalty set forth in ORS 153.018 (2)(e),
15 the [*fine shall be waived*] **violation shall be dismissed.** Failure to pay the
16 fine shall not be a basis for further penalties or for a term of incarceration.

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“OVERSIGHT AND ADMINISTRATION

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20 **“SECTION 23.** Section 23, chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2021 (Ballot Measure
21 110 (2020)), is amended to read:

1 “**Sec. 23.** [*Implementation.*] (1) Not later than February 1, 2021, the
2 Oregon Health Authority[, *Health Systems Division Behavioral Health Ser-*
3 *vices*] shall establish a statewide temporary telephone Addiction Recovery
4 Center. The temporary telephone Addiction Recovery Center shall be staffed
5 [*twenty-four*] **24** hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. The tem-
6 porary telephone Addiction Recovery Center shall provide the services set
7 forth in section 2 [(2)(b)(i)-(iii)] **(2)(c)(A) to (C), chapter 2, Oregon Laws**
8 **2021 (Ballot Measure 110 (2020))**, and the verification set forth in section
9 2 [(2)(e)] **(2)(f), chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2021 (Ballot Measure 110**
10 **(2020))**.

11 “(2) **Notwithstanding ORS 153.018**, until such time as an Addiction Re-
12 covery Center is established in the coordinated care organization service
13 area where a person subject to the penalty set forth in ORS 153.018 (2)(e) for
14 a violation that has been classified or reclassified as a Class E violation
15 [*pursuant to section 11 to section 19*] **under ORS 475.752, 475.824, 475.834,**
16 **475.854, 475.874, 475.884 and 475.894** resides, the person shall be fined up to
17 \$100, but in lieu of the fine may complete a health assessment, as set forth
18 in section 2 [(2)(b)(ii)] **(2)(c)(B), chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2021 (Ballot**
19 **Measure 110 (2020))**, through the temporary telephone Addiction Recovery
20 Center. Upon verification that the person has received a health assessment
21 through the temporary telephone Addiction Recovery Center within 45 days
22 of when the person receives a citation for a violation subject to the penalty
23 set forth in ORS 153.018 (2)(e), the [*fine shall be waived*] **violation shall be**
24 **dismissed**. Failure to pay the fine shall not be a basis for further penalties
25 or for a term of incarceration.

26 “(3) When an Addiction Recovery Center is established in each coordi-
27 nated care organization service area, and not later than October 1, 2021, the
28 temporary telephone Addiction Recovery Center shall be terminated.”.

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
