## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2510

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "requirements" delete the rest 2 of the line and insert a period.

3 Delete lines 3 through 19.

4 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 12 and insert:

<sup>5</sup> "Whereas statistical data from the National Safety Council and the Na-<sup>6</sup> tional Center for Health Statistics indicate that firearms are involved in 1.5 <sup>7</sup> percent of accidental fatalities nationwide, far behind deaths due to motor <sup>8</sup> vehicle accidents (47 percent), falls (15 percent), poisonings (10 percent), <sup>9</sup> drownings (four percent), fires (three percent), suffocation on ingested ob-<sup>10</sup> jects (three percent) and other causes; and

"Whereas the syllabus of the opinion of the Supreme Court of the United States in the case District of Columbia v. Heller states 'The handgun ban and the trigger-lock requirement (as applied to self-defense) violate the Second Amendment'; and

Heller states 'Similarly, the re-<sup>17</sup> quirement that any lawful firearm in the home be dissembled or bound by a <sup>18</sup> trigger lock makes it impossible for citizens to use arms for the core lawful <sup>19</sup> purpose of self-defense and is hence unconstitutional'; now, therefore,".

a firearm safety education curriculum for students in grades 7 through
 9.

"(2) Each school district shall ensure that students in grades 7
through 9 receive instruction in accordance with the firearm safety
education curriculum described in subsection (1) of this section.

6 "(3) The department or a school district may contract with an out-7 side entity to develop the curriculum or provide the instruction de-8 scribed in this section.

9 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law, a person who lawfully
10 owns a firearm and stores the firearm inside the person's home is
11 safely and lawfully storing the firearm.

12 "SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law, a person who lawfully 13 owns a firearm and stores the firearm inside the person's motor ve-14 hicle, in accordance with ORS 166.250 and while the person is inside 15 the vehicle, is safely and lawfully storing the firearm.".
