**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 570**

1 On page 4 of the printed bill, line 2, after “organization” insert “with a
2 plan approved by the Department of Environmental Quality under section 6
3 of this 2021 Act”.

4 In line 8, delete “Department of Environmental Quality” and insert “de-
5 partment”.

6 In line 33, delete “or pay legal fees associated with legal action taken by
7 the state”.

8 On page 5, delete lines 37 through 41 and insert:

9 “(j) Provide a mechanism to mitigate the costs associated with collection
10 and management of discarded mattresses that are illegally dumped. The pro-
11 posed mechanism must take into account the cost of one or more incentives
12 to encourage collectors to properly dispose of discarded mattresses and dis-
13 courage illegal dumping, and may include but need not be limited to pro-
14 posals for funding of cleanup activities, for education and outreach or for
15 studies to evaluate the causes of illegal dumping. The proposed mechanism
16 may not require the stewardship organization or collectors to enter private
17 property without authorization from the property owner or other appropriate
18 authority.”.

19 On page 6, delete lines 37 through 41 and insert:

20 “(b) A plan may provide for methods for providing convenient service that
21 are alternative methods to those provided for in paragraph (a) of this sub-

1 section if, based on a geographic information systems analysis or additional
2 information, the alternative methods will result in providing service to resi-
3 dents throughout this state at an equivalent level of convenient service
4 compared with the methods provided for under paragraph (a) of this sub-
5 section.”

6 On page 9, delete lines 3 through 6 and insert:

7 “(4) If the department determines that a change for which notice was
8 given under subsection (3) of this section has a material impact on a previ-
9 ously approved plan, the department may require the stewardship organiza-
10 tion to submit an amendment under subsection (1) of this section, regardless
11 of whether the change has been implemented.”.

12 In line 8, delete “four” and insert “five”.

13 In line 11, delete “four” and insert “five”.

14 Delete lines 33 through 41 and insert:

15 “(b) Information on the number and tonnage of discarded mattresses col-
16 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program during the previous
17 calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to determine how the
18 program is performing in different regions of the state;

19 “(c) Information on the number and tonnage of program mattresses col-
20 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program for recycling during the
21 previous calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to determine
22 how the program is performing in different regions of the state;

23 “(d) Information on the number and tonnage of program mattresses col-
24 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program for renovation during
25 the previous calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to deter-
26 mine how the program is performing in different regions of the state;”.

27 On page 10, delete lines 6 through 11 and insert:

28 “(h) The number of discarded mattresses received through collection that
29 were not program mattresses, the number of discarded mattresses that were
30 illegally dumped as reported to the department, an analysis of how the data

1 required by this paragraph has changed over time and strategies the
2 stewardship organization will take to address discarded mattresses that are
3 not program mattresses and discarded mattresses that are illegally
4 dumped;”.

5 On page 11, line 12, delete “four” and insert “five”.

6 In line 16, delete “four” and insert “five”.

7 On page 13, lines 10 through 12, delete the boldfaced material.
