PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 584

1 Delete lines 5 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>"SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Department of Human Services shall administer a program to provide medical assistance to employed individuals
with disabilities residing in this state who qualify for Medicaid under
42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(10)(ii)(XVI).

6 "(2) The department may not consider an individual's income or 7 resources in determining eligibility for the program described in sub-8 section (1) of this section or establish an age limit to qualify for the 9 program. The department may consider an individual's income in de-10 termining premium or other cost-sharing requirements if necessary 11 to administer the program within available funds.

"(3) The department shall coordinate benefits available under the
 program described in subsection (1) of this section with an individual's
 employer-sponsored health insurance, if any.

"(4) The department shall seek federal approval necessary to exclude from consideration earnings accumulated in a separate account
while an individual participates in the program described in subsection
(1) of this section when determining the individual's eligibility for
medical assistance under ORS 414.706.".

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
