**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 50**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “programs;” delete the rest of
2 the line and delete line 3 and insert “creating new provisions; amending ORS
3 329A.030, 329A.250, 329A.252, 329A.255, 329A.390 and 419B.005; repealing ORS
4 329A.257; and prescribing an effective date.”.

5 On page 5, lines 11 through 13, delete the boldfaced material.

6 On page 10, after line 30, insert:

7 **“SECTION 8. (1) As used in this section, ‘program’ means a pre-**
8 **school recorded program or a school-age recorded program, as those**
9 **terms are defined in ORS 329A.250.**

10 **“(2) Notwithstanding ORS 329A.030, a program may continue to**
11 **employ an individual who is not enrolled in the Central Background**
12 **Registry on January 2, 2022, if:**

13 **“(a) The individual was employed by the program on and before**
14 **January 2, 2022;**

15 **“(b) The program completed a criminal background check for the**
16 **individual before January 2, 2022;**

17 **“(c) The individual has submitted an application for enrollment in**
18 **the Central Background Registry not later than June 30, 2022; and**

19 **“(d) The office has not issued a notice of intent to deny the**
20 **individual’s application for enrollment in the Central Background**
21 **Registry.**

1 **“(3) Notwithstanding ORS 329A.030, a program may continue to al-**
2 **low an individual who is not enrolled in the Central Background Reg-**
3 **istry on January 2, 2022, to volunteer in the program if:**

4 **“(a) The individual was volunteering in the program on and before**
5 **January 2, 2022;**

6 **“(b) The program completed a criminal background check for the**
7 **individual before January 2, 2022;**

8 **“(c) The individual has submitted an application for enrollment in**
9 **the Central Background Registry not later than June 30, 2022; and**

10 **“(d) The office has not issued a notice of intent to deny the**
11 **individual’s application for enrollment in the Central Background**
12 **Registry.**

13 **“SECTION 9. The Office of Child Care may accept and process ap-**
14 **plications for enrollment in the Central Background Registry that are**
15 **submitted under section 8 of this 2021 Act and received by the office**
16 **before, on or after January 2, 2022.**

17 **“SECTION 10. Sections 8 and 9 of this 2021 Act are repealed on**
18 **January 2, 2024.**

19 **“SECTION 11. (1) Section 8 of this 2021 Act, the amendments to ORS**
20 **329A.030, 329A.250, 329A.252, 329A.255, 329A.390 and 419B.005 by sections**
21 **1 to 6 of this 2021 Act and the repeal of ORS 329A.257 by section 7 of**
22 **this 2021 Act become operative on January 2, 2022.**

23 **“(2) The Office of Child Care and the Early Learning Council may**
24 **take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1)**
25 **of this section that is necessary for the office or council to exercise,**
26 **on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this sec-**
27 **tion, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the office**
28 **or the council by section 8 of this 2021 Act, the amendments to ORS**
29 **329A.030, 329A.250, 329A.252, 329A.255, 329A.390 and 419B.005 by sections**
30 **1 to 6 of this 2021 Act and the repeal of ORS 329A.257 by section 7 of**

1 **this 2021 Act.**

2 **“SECTION 12. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
3 **date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative**
4 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
